## **JOINT LOCAL PLAN**

The cabinet has assessed the Draft Joint Local Plan, which sets out the preferred strategic policies, Development management policies and site allocations to guide and support development in the two districts, prior to a Regulation 18 public consultation. Full council will now be able to debate and vote on it in January.

# **WEIGHT RESTRICTION – WATER STREET**

The temporary weight restriction (one way) in Water Street is set to start in January. Lorries are no longer able to turn left into Water Street from the High Street (other than for access). The intention is to reduce the amount of lorries using Lavenham in either direction. Highways will monitor the situation and if successful then they will consider a more permanent restriction.
