## KINGFISHER LEISURE CENTRE BOOST

Babergh District Council is investing £2,350k - with £100k of the funds provided through the Community Infrastructure Levy monies - to extend and refurbish the Sudbury Kingfisher Leisure Centre.

Beardwell Construction has been appointed to carry out the works which began on Tuesday 23 April 2019.

The Kingfisher Leisure Centre will remain open during the work which has been phased to ensure that dance, fitness and swimming activities can continue to be provided during construction. The new facilities are expected to be open to the public in March 2020.

## Works include;

- Two storey extension to provide ground floor studio/community room and first floor dance studio
- Refurbished and extended first floor fitness studio (gym) increasing the current 40 exercise stations to 100 exercise stations
- New ground floor changing facilities for members
- Fully refurbished poolside wet changing and toilet facilities
- Improved lighting and décor
- New air handling systems and modern mechanical plant
