Babergh District Council has appointed Carter Jonas to conduct an options and appraisal study on the future of the former Delphi Industries site in Sudbury.

The study has been commissioned as part of Babergh's commitments as a member of the South Suffolk Taskforce and will consist of a focused month-long options and appraisal study to determine the most sustainable future for the 9-hectare site, situated off Newton Road in Sudbury.
